**Matthew 19:14:** "Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs."

**Luke 13:29:** People will come from the east and west, from the north and south, and will eat in the kingdom of God.

**Revelation 7:9:** After this I looked, and there was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, from all the tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne [of God]...
